# ABOUT ASEAN CLASSROOM

ASEAN Classroom (ACL) is an edu-tourism program that combines the study of international law with travel and cultural exploration in Malaysia. Designed for law students, professionals, and those interested in international law within the ASEAN region, ACL offers practical insights into areas like public international law and others. Participants visit legal institutions, engage in simulated negotiations, and interact with legal professionals, developing key skills in cross-cultural communication, teamwork, and critical thinking to prepare future leaders in international law.

The program has been successfully running for 8 years, starting in 2016. Initially named 'International Law Summer School,' it was renamed 'ASEAN Classroom' in 2019. Thanks to the dedication of coordinators and committee members, the program has continued annually with international student participation. Even during the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, the program continued virtually through 'ACL-DREAM,' in collaboration with Indonesia's Universitas Gadjah Mada, attracting participants from Indonesia, the Philippines, Sweden, Australia, and Ghana. In 2022, ACL returned to in-person sessions, starting with 5 international and 5 local students. By 2023, participation grew to 18 students from 6 universities, both local and international. This edu-tourism program is recognized by local and international universities and faculties, and has garnered media attention from outlets such as Utusan and Bernama TV.

# RUMAH PENGHULU ABU SEMAN

The Rumah Penghulu Abu Seman is among the oldest remaining traditional Malay houses. Constructed in phases from 1910 to the early 1930s, it once belonged to the village headman of Mukim Bagan Samak in Bandar Baharu, Kedah. Initially situated in Kampung Sungai Kechil, a small village in northern Peninsular Malaysia, the house was saved, moved, and restored by Badan Warisan Malaysia between 1996 and 1997.

# DATARAN MERDEKA

Dataran Merdeka, or Merdeka Square, is a historic site in Kuala Lumpur where Malaysia declared its independence on August 31, 1957. Once a colonial-era field, it became a symbol of freedom when the Malayan flag was raised for the first time. Surrounded by iconic landmarks like the Sultan Abdul Samad Building, the square remains a proud venue for national celebrations and a reminder of the country's journey to independence.



# CENTRAL MARKET

Central Market, established in 1888 by Chinese Kapitan Yap Ah Loy as a wet market, became a notable landmark in Kuala Lumpur. After being saved from demolition in the 1980s, it was transformed into a vibrant hub for tourists, shoppers, and art enthusiasts.

Now, Central Market Kuala Lumpur is an iconic attraction and a delightful destination for tourists, shoppers and art lovers.



# MERDEKA 118

Merdeka 118, also known as Merdeka PNB 118 or Warisan Merdeka Tower, is a 118-story, 678.9-meter skyscraper in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Completed in mid-2022, it's the world's second-tallest structure and building, surpassing Tokyo Skytree and Shanghai Tower.

Named "Merdeka" (meaning "independence") due to its location near Stadium Merdeka and Stadium Negara, it stands as the tallest building in Malaysia and Southeast Asia.



# PETRONAS TWIN TOWER

The Petronas Twin Towers pierce the Kuala Lumpur skyline with stunning elegance, standing 452 meters tall as the world's tallest twin towers. Linked by a skybridge high in the clouds, they offer breathtaking views and a thrilling taste of Malaysia's futuristic spirit, an iconic landmark that's pure architectural magic!



# MELAKA RIVER

The Malacca River, which runs through the heart of Malacca City in Malaysia, was a crucial trade route during the height of the Malacca Sultanate in the 15th century. Originating from the foothills of neighboring Negeri Sembilan, it flows into the Strait of Malacca.



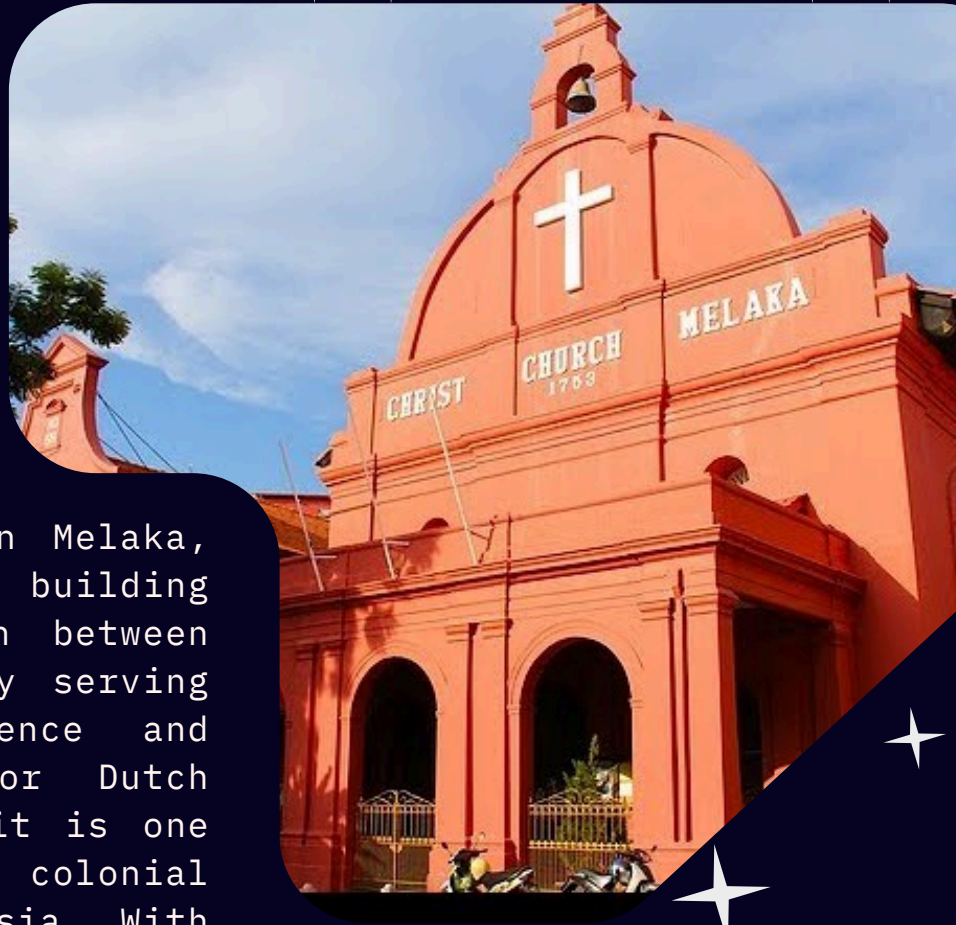
# A'FAMOSA

A Famosa in Melaka is a thrilling gateway to the past, an ancient Portuguese fortress that once guarded a bustling port of empires and explorers. Though only a crumbling stone gate remains, it pulses with history and mystery, whispering tales of battles, treasure, and colonial power. Standing before it feels like stepping into a real-life adventure story!



# CHRIST CHURCH

The Stadthuys, located in Melaka, Malaysia, is a historical building constructed by the Dutch between 1641 and 1660. Originally serving as the official residence and administrative center for Dutch governors and officers, it is one of the oldest Dutch colonial buildings in Southeast Asia. With its distinctive red exterior and Dutch architectural style, the Stadthuys now houses the History and Ethnography Museum, showcasing Melaka's rich cultural and colonial past.



# REDANG ISLAND

Redang Island, located off the east coast of Malaysia, is renowned for its pristine white beaches, crystal-clear turquoise waters, and vibrant marine life. A favored destination for snorkeling, diving, and tranquil retreats, the island offers a serene yet captivating escape, combining natural beauty with a sense of refined tropical charm.



# CRYSTAL MOSQUE

The Crystal Mosque, located in Terengganu, stands as a stunning fusion of modern architecture and Islamic elegance. Built from steel, glass, and crystal, its shimmering domes and graceful structure reflect beautifully over the waters of the Terengganu River. As both a place of worship and a landmark of cultural pride, it offers visitors a truly majestic and serene experience.



# TERENGGANU STATE MUSEUM

The Terengganu State Museum, the largest in Southeast Asia, showcases the rich cultural heritage of the region through traditional textiles, weapons, Islamic art, and the historic Terengganu Inscription Stone. Set in a stunning complex of traditional Malay-style buildings, it offers a captivating journey through history, including maritime and fisheries museums, and beautifully preserved heritage exhibits.



# PASAR PAYANG

Pasar Payang, located along the Terengganu River in Kuala Terengganu, is a vibrant central market renowned for its rich cultural offerings. Housed in a modern two-storey building, it features a diverse array of traditional handicrafts, including batik, songket, and brassware, alongside fresh produce and local delicacies like keropok lekor and satar. Beyond shopping, the market serves as a cultural hub where visitors can immerse themselves in the local lifestyle and flavors of Terengganu.



# BIDONG ISLAND

Bidong Island, off Terengganu's coast, is a historically significant site once housing Vietnamese refugees. Today, it features pristine beaches, clear waters, and vibrant marine life, making it an ideal spot for snorkeling, diving, and exploring its fascinating history.
