XXX MODEL UNITED NATIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAVANA

The Organizing Committee of the **Model United Nations of the University of Havana (HAVMUN)**, with the collaboration of the Cuban Association of the United Nations (ACNU) and the University of Havana (UH), calls for participation in the XXX Edition of the Havana Model United Nations, HAVMUN 2026, to be held from May 4 to 8, 2026, at the University of Havana, Havana, Cuba.

Our model, organized and led by university students since 1996, boasts **thirty years of academic experience** as a scientific forum of excellence at the international and national levels, making it the oldest and most important Model United Nations in Cuba.

The event consists of a simulation of the debates and discussions of the bodies and agencies that make up the United Nations system, where students represent different States on the various topics that constitute the discussion agenda.

**HAVMUN 2026** opens its doors to Cuban and foreign university students to debate under the central theme: **“HAVMUN 30: A Legacy that Inspires and Diplomacy that Transforms.”**

As part of the event, delegates will simulate working committees in three official United Nations languages (**Spanish, English, and French**), in which the following main bodies and their respective topics will be simulated:
